Investigations of such clusters almost never identify a causal link between exposure and disease.(18,19) Nevertheless, many health departments have learned that they must be “responsibly responsive” to public concerns, even if they think that an epidemiologic link is unlikely.(7,8,20) Similarly, the public may fear that an outbreak is the result of an intentional criminal or bioterrorist act.

1. An outbreak investigation leader should be identified. This person should be sufficiently senior in the health care facility management to take responsibility for the actions required to manage the outbreak and should receive full delegated authority from the institutional head. 2. Convene an outbreak investigation team.

Detecting an outbreak is the first step in investigating a multistate foodborne outbreak. An outbreak with multiple sick people can be missed if they are spread out over a wide area. Outbreaks are detected by using public health surveillance methods, including PulseNet, formal reports of illnesses, and informal reports of illnesses.
